We chose cool climate Monterey grapes for the exceptional texture they provide and Paso Robles for its rich and spicy berry characters. Blended with grapes from Estancia's Pinnacles Vineyard in Monterey and Keyes Canyon Vineyard in Paso Robles, this vibrant and delicious Syrah is an approachable, pleasing wine.
